TOURISM CARES DEPLOY RECOVERY RESOURCES TO SPUR CARIBBEAN TOURISM

MIAMI (August 3, 2018) - The Caribbean Tourism Recovery Fund, established by the nonprofit organization Tourism Cares and the Caribbean Hotel and Tourism Association (CHTA), collected more than US\$275,000 in charitable donations to build long-term recovery and enhance the ability of hurricane impacted destinations to rebound as quickly as possible.



In a joint statement CHTA President Frank Comito and Paula Vlamings, CEO of Tourism Cares, outlined the success of the collaborative fundraising venture and reported that assistance has gone to Caribbean nations and territories for training and education, restoring destination capacity, the physical restoration of tourism-related infrastructure, social enterprise development, job creation, hotel training, voluntourism, marketing and public relations support, and the environment.
