The Ministry of Attorney General & Legal Affairs has issued an Amnesty from Penalties for Companies for the following post-incorporation documents:

- Notice of Secretary/Assistant Secretary (ties) or change thereof
- Annual Return
- Notice of change of Directors
- Notice of change of address
- Notice of execution or termination of unanimous shareholder agreement

This Amnesty runs from May 1st- August 31st, 2019.
